Seasonal, Full-time

Reports to: Master Electrician and Asst. Electrician
Start Date: Late May
End Date: Late August/early September
Work Week: 6 days, 8-10 hours/day, often overnight during changeovers, day off may vary week to week
Housing: Shared room, kitchen and bath in company housing

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Assist with the preparation, maintenance, lighting hang, focus, and performance runs for 7 shows on 2 stages
- Work with lighting department on equipment maintenance, cabling, patching, and trouble-shooting
- Run follow spot for musicals
- Serve as light board operator as needed
- Design lighting and provide support for Cabaret productions
- Assist in other departments as assigned
- Assist in the upkeep, cleanup and maintenance of work areas and equipment
- Attend Intern Meetings
- Provide support for special events or company projects as needed

REQUIREMENTS:

- Proven interest and skills in standard lighting techniques and practices
- Comfortable working at heights and in tight, awkward spaces is essential
- Minimum of 1 year experience and/or study, preferably at the university level, in lighting design and or crew work
- Excellent inter-personal, organizational, collaborative, and communication skills
- Knowledge of and respect for adhering to industry and OSHA standard safety practices
- Ability to safely lift up to 50 pounds
- Ability and willingness to work long days with irregular schedules with positive attitude
- Valid driver's license
- Ability to thrive in rural area with limited cell service
