Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- As needed, support either the Paints Department or Scenic Department in construction and painting of all scenic elements for seven shows produced on two stages.
- This position provides support to both departments at our off site scene shop
- Assist in the upkeep, cleanup and maintenance of work areas and equipment
- Assist other production departments as necessary, especially during changeovers
- Assist in loading, unloading and securing items in rented scenery truck
- Serve on running crew for productions as needed
- Attend Intern Meetings
- Provide support for special events and company projects as directed

REQUIREMENTS:

- Proven interest and skills in standard scenic construction and paint techniques and practices; comfortable working at heights and in tight, awkward spaces is essential
- Minimum of 1 year experience and/or study, preferably at the university level, in scenic fabrication and crew work
- Excellent inter-personal, organizational, collaborative, communication skills
- Knowledge of and respect for adhering to industry and OSHA standard safety practices
- Ability to safely lift up to 50 pounds
- Ability and willingness to work long days with irregular schedules with positive attitude
- Valid driver's license with clean record. Own car preferred. All business related trips will be reimbursed
- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Ability to thrive in rural area with limited cell phone service
