## TheatreLab

TheatreLab meets for eight sessions on Sundays, June-August. All performances begin at 3:00pm, **expect for *The Phantom Tollbooth*, which begins at 4:00pm**. Please plan to arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each show and one hour prior on the first day. All of the Sunday matinees are followed by a talkback, where students will have the opportunity to ask members of the cast and creative staff questions about each show. There will also be two workshop days **that start at noon**, where students will meet with production staff and learn about different technical departments. Additionally, TheatreLab students will be invited to observe two Wednesday evening technical rehearsals throughout the summer (TBA). At the end of the program, students will present a final project on a subject of their choosing, related to something they learned throughout the program.
