**Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:**

- Assist scene shop staff with proper construction, fabrication, installation, rigging, and strike of scenic elements for 7 shows produced on 2 stages in offsite scene shop
- Consistent tool maintenance and inspection for standard and safe operation at all times
- Assist in the upkeep, cleanup, and maintenance of work areas and equipment
- Assist other production departments as necessary
- Assist in loading, unloading and securing items in rented scenery truck
- Serve on running crew for productions as needed
- Attend Intern Meetings
- Provide support for special events and company projects as directed

**REQUIREMENTS:**

- Proven interest and skills in standard scenic construction techniques and practices; comfortable working at heights and in tight, awkward spaces is essential
- Minimum of 1 year experience and/or study, preferably at the university level, in scenic fabrication and crew work
- Excellent inter-personal, organizational, collaborative, and communication skills
- Knowledge of and respect for adhering to industry and OSHA standard safety practices
- Ability to safely lift up to 50 pounds
- Ability and willingness to work long days with irregular schedules with positive attitude
