Reports to: Charge Artist and Scenic Artist
Start Date: Late May
End Date: late August/early September
Work Week: 6 days, 8-10 hours/day, often overnight during changeovers, day off may vary week to week
Housing: Shared room, kitchen and bath in company housing

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Assist with the painting of all scenic and prop elements for seven shows on two stages and off site scene shop
- Work with Scenic Team on necessary paperwork, purchasing, research, preparing samples, etc
- Assist in the upkeep, cleanup and maintenance of work areas and equipment
- Provide support for other departments, special events or company projects as needed
- Attend Intern Meetings
- Serve as run crew as needed

REQUIREMENTS:

- Proven interest and skills in standard scenic art techniques and practices
- Minimum of 1 year experience in scenic art or equivalent
- Excellent inter-personal, organizational, collaborative, communication skills
- Knowledge of and respect for adhering to industry and OSHA standard safety practices
- Ability to thrive in a rural area with limited cell phone service
- Personal car a plus. All company related trips will be reimbursed
- Ability and willingness to work long days with irregular hours with a positive attitude
